### ITINERARY DETAILS

#### DAY 1

Arrive to Rome and take a private transfer to your hotel accommodations. Time will be given to check in, and acquaint yourself to your home over the next few days. Settle in before a welcome lunch (or dinner) with the school staff of instructors. **(D)**

#### DAY 2

Morning breakfast and then your cultural week begins with the first of your morning language classes. Each class will last for 2 hours. In the afternoon the first of your excursions included to give you not only a taste for local wine, but also the opportunity to incorporate some of you initial knowledge of the language. Later return to your accommodations and the evening at your leisure. **(B, W)**

#### DAY 3

Morning breakfast and then start the day with the morning language class (2 hours). In the afternoon a walk to the historical town center to visit an archeological museum, followed by an Italian tradition - the afternoon walk and then a stop for "*aperitivo*". **(B)**

#### DAY 4

Breakfast and morning language secession (2 hours). The afternoon offers another excursion to a well known wine *enoteca* for a wine and cheese tasting - all of course conducted in Italian. **(B, W)**

#### DAY 5

Morning breakfast followed by 2 hours of class instruction. In the afternoon a chance to further employ your newly acquired language skills as you will have time for shopping, or visiting a local museum. In the evening more time to explore the language as you participate in a cooking class - featuring the best way to make real Italian Pizza! **(B, D)**

#### DAY 6

## **TERMS & CONDITIONS**

**Introduction:** The Opera Tour is one of our Special Event tours. It is NOT, however, on every occasion an Escorted Group Tour. The tour is organized in such a way to accommodate as few as two persons or a small group. The tour is a combination of services and products designed for customers that wish to enjoy the freedom of an un-escorted trip with the assurance that all the details of the itinerary have been arranged ahead of their arrival. The support for the tour comes from the personnel in Italy who we know personally and have worked with for many years. Hotel personnel, the transportation drivers and official tour guides whom we “employ” for their services all agree with our expectation to provide our clients with a high level of customer service and attention.

**Payments:** A 40% deposit is required in order to confirm your reservation. Payments can be made by credit card (VISA, M/C, AMEX) or by bank transfer. The balance payment will be due 60 days prior to the Start Date for your selected tour. With credit card payments, the balance payment will automatically be charged to the credit card provided, unless the reservation is otherwise cancelled or notice is given to use an alternate form of payment.

**Cancellations:** Due to the nature of Special Events and the ticketing and reservation process, Tickets purchased for any opera performance, cannot be refunded for any reason. Refunds for hotel accommodations or other travel options supplied for any cancelled Special Event package will be subject to the refund schedule found below.

**Performance Cancellations:** Cancellations by La Scala or the Verona Arena Foundation of their respective performances are refundable. Verona Opera performances cancelled due to weather conditions are subject to the terms of the Verona Foundation, which essentially state Tickets can only be refunded if the performance does not complete the 1st act.

**IF YOU DECIDE TO CANCEL, YOU MUST NOTIFY THE COMPANY IN WRITING OF YOUR INTENT TO CANCEL.** If you cancel a reservation and the written cancellation is received within 30 days from the date you made the reservation, then all fees paid will be refunded, with exception to the provisions for Tickets stated above and otherwise net of credit card service charges.

After the first 30 days of your reservation period, deposits and payments for accommodations will follow the refund schedule below. If you cancel after the first 30-day period and someone takes your place, then administrative cancellation fees may apply, in addition to Ticket costs, which will be deducted from your deposit or payments.

After the 30 day initial reservation period, but  
Prior to 90 days before Start Date: Refund, less 25% of total cost, net of Tickets;  
Prior to 60 days before Start Date: Refund, less 50% of total cost, net of Tickets;  
Prior to 45 days before Start Date: Refund, less 75% of total cost, net of Tickets;  
Less than 45 days before Start Date: No refunds.

No refunds are made for unused portions of any reservation, including but not limited to missed meals, missed guided tours, Tickets (includes airline tickets), or non-use of hotel room.

**Passports & Visas:** All customers must possess a valid passport and/or any visas or special travel documents that can be used as a proof of citizenship. The Company accepts no liability for clients improperly documented.
